

LICENCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Memorial Wall

- These Terms and Conditions apply to all use of the Memorial Wall erected at the front of Saint Barnabas Anglican Church of Roseneath ("Church").
- The sole purpose of the Memorial Wall is to allow a place on the parish property of the Church for the memorialisation on a plaque of those interred elsewhere.
- 3. The Memorial Wall shall consist of uniform plaques containing the name, date of birth, date of death of the person being memorialised, and, if desired, a short inscription, all in an approved form.

Management

- 4. Management and control of the Memorial Wall is the direct responsibility of the Memorial Wall Committee ("Committee") as appointed by the Vestry of the Church (or, if no Committee is appointed, the Vestry itself). The Committee has, among other things, the sole right, discretion and/or responsibility:
 - to approve all plaques and inscriptions, including the memorialisation of any particular person;
 - (b) for the provision and mounting of all plaques on, and for all work and maintenance done in relation to, the Memorial Wall. No mounting, addition, modification or removal of plaques, or other use of the Memorial Wall, by any person, shall be permitted except as authorised by the Committee;
 - (c) to determine where any plaque will be placed on the Memorial Wall; and
 - (d) to at any time extend, alter or reduce the size, shape or structure of the Memorial Wall.

Licences

- Acquisition and placement of a plaque on the Memorial Wall can only occur under a licence issued by the Committee under these Terms and Conditions ("Licence").
- Licences may be acquired by members or former members of the Church or parish and, in the sole discretion of the Committee, to other individuals in the community.
- 7. A Licence may be purchased from the Committee, at a price stipulated by the Committee from time to time, which includes:
 - (a) The cost of a uniform black granite plaque, with desired inscription.
 - (b) The cost of installing and maintaining the plaque upon the Memorial Wall.
 - (c) The right to have the plaque remain in place on the Memorial Wall in perpetuity, except as limited by these Terms and Conditions.

- For inscriptions, Licensees may choose from a prescribed set of fonts, phrases and graphic adornments as approved by the Committee. No other fonts, phrases, adornments, graphics or markings will be permitted.
- 9. Any changes or additions to the inscription on a plaque subsequently desired by a Licensee shall be notified in writing to the Committee, who shall, upon receipt of payment for the alteration work from the Licensee, arrange for the alteration to be carried out as soon as practicable.
- 10. If the Licensee has not specified the person(s) to be memorialised on the plaque within 3 months following the date of purchase of the Licence, a blank plaque may be mounted on the Memorial Wall by the Committee to mark the licensed space.
- 11. If a Licensee has not specified the person(s) to be memorialised on the plaque within twenty (20) years from the date of purchase of the Licence, the Licence shall terminate sixty (60) days after written notice by the Committee is posted to the Licensee at the last address provided to the Committee. Upon receipt of such notice, the Licence may be renewed once only, for a further ten (10) years, if the Licensee advises the Committee in writing, within the sixty (60) days following the giving of the notice, of their continuing intention to use the Licence.
- 12. The purchase of a Licence does not grant to the Licensee any legal title or any other property right in respect of the plaque or the Memorial Wall, nor to any particular space upon the Memorial Wall.
- 13. A Licence as granted by the Committee is vested only in the original Licensee, and may not be sold, assigned, transferred or conveyed in any manner without the written consent of the Committee.

General

- 14. All Licensees shall be subject to these Terms and Conditions at all times.
- 15. Any breach of these Terms and Conditions by a Licensee shall result in the immediate termination of the Licence without refund of the purchase price, unless otherwise authorised by the Committee.
- These Terms and Conditions may be modified, amended or changed at any time by the Committee or Vestry in its sole discretion. However, the Committee shall make reasonable efforts to notify each living Licensee of any amendments to these Terms and Conditions.
- 17. The Licensee shall be responsible for notifying the Committee of any change of his/her address.
- 18. Any and all matters arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the Memorial Wall not provided for in these Terms and Conditions shall be determined by the Vestry of the day by a majority vote.
